



**Nørhalne Cup** is organized for the 28th time at the Ascension Holiday, in 2012 from May 17-20. In 2011 Nørhalne Cup had participants almost 550 teams from 14 countries – Brazil, England, USA, Russia, Finland, the Netherlands, Ireland, Norway, Sweden, Germany, Czech Republic, Ukraine, Italy and Denmark.

Classes starting with "B" are for boys, "G" are for Girls, and "E" are for the Elite.

**Arrival and departure** – Teams can arrive from Wednesday May 16th at 17.00 and stay until Sunday May 20th at 10.00.

**Age dispensation** – Each team in 11-a-side can include a maximum of three players born up to six months prior to the birth date of the team age group. Each team in 7-a-side can include a maximum of two players born up to six months prior to the birth date of the team age group.

**Tournament** – The matches start Thursday May 17th at 9.00 with preliminary matches until 20.00. On Friday May 18th the intermediate groups are played, and Saturday May 19th is the day of placing matches and finals.

**Meals** – Full board from breakfast on Thursday May 17th to breakfast on Sunday May 20th.

**Accommodation in Schools.** All participants bring their own mattress and sleeping bag.

**Bus transport** – The tournament buses run between all schools and fields. There are busses several times per hour and it is free for the participants to use it.

**Faarup Sommerland** – All participants get the possibility to visit Faarup Sommerland. Faarup Sommerland is located 20 km from Nørhalne and is one of Denmark's most successful fun parks with lots of opportunities for activity. When the entry ticket is paid are the amusements free. If you need our transport to Faarup Sommerland the cost is £5.50 per person.

**Participation Card A: £85.00 per person.** Includes: participation in the tournament, full board from breakfast Thursday May 17th to breakfast Sunday May 20th, school accommodation, medals for all players, trophy for all teams, free tournament bus transport.

**Participation Card B: £95.00 per person.** Includes: participation in the tournament, full board from breakfast Thursday May 17th to breakfast Sunday May 20th, school accommodation, medals for all players, trophy for all teams, free tournament bus transport, and entry ticket to Faarup Sommerland (Bus transport not included).

**Hotel / Hostel** – If you wish to be accommodated at hotel or youth hostel, there are several opportunities. For players and leaders with Participation Card A accommodation at youth hostel with full board are **£160.00** with three nights stay, and **£180.00** with four nights stay.

**Team fee: A fee of £175.00 per team covers participation in the tournament.**
