



This summer tournament is held in the capital of Estonia - Tallinn. In 2011 99 teams from Estonia, Latvia, Russia and Finland participated, whilst in 2012 about 150-170 teams are expected.



Tallinn with its beauty and a location on the east coast of the Baltic Sea is a major attraction for tourists from Finland, Sweden, Latvia, Lithuania and Russia. The main purpose of the tournament is to develop and popularise football in Estonia by giving local teams a chance to meet with foreign opponents and gain new and much-needed experience. In addition to teams from Estonia, participants from Finland, Sweden, Russia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Slovakia, Denmark, Norway, Germany, England and other European countries are expected to enter the tournament.

All participants can also see the best U19 teams in Europe play matches. From the 11th of July all Tallinn Cup 2012 players, coaches and parents can see the U19 finals from quarterfinal stage up to the final on the 15th of July. Tallinn Cup 2012 and Estonia Football Federation have a good cooperation and all players and coaches get free tickets to the U19 Euro Championship games.

AGE GROUPS

Boys, U17, 16, 15, 14 and 13 all play 11-a-side whilst U12 and U11 play 8-side, U9 and U8 play 7-a-side and U7 play 6-a-side. There are also three **Girls** sections Ladies, U17 and U15 all play 11-a-side.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Wednesday 11th July

Teams arrive to Tallinn during the day and check into your accommodation. First meal is dinner this evening.

Thursday 12th July

First round of games start from 08.00hrs, last match is played at 18.00hrs

Friday 13th July

All games continues from 08.00hrs, last match is played at 18.00hrs plus the opportunity to take sightseeing options such as a tour of the Old Town or the Zoo. In the evening a leaders party is arranged from 7-midnight.

Saturday 14th July

Play-offs and Finals games start from 08.00hrs, last match is played at 18.00hrs plus more sightseeing options are available such as a tour of the Estonian National Football Stadium and the Estonian Open Air Museum, not forgetting Kalev Spa the biggest water park in Tallinn.

Sunday 15th July

More Finals. games start from 08.30hrs, last match is played at 14.00hrs Last meal (Lunch) is served between 11.00-15.00hrs. Teams depart.

TOURNAMENT COSTS

School accommodation is £115.00 per person. Sleeping bag or beds are not included in the price. Minimum one, maximum four leaders per team may stay in the school. **Hotel accommodation costs £223.00 per person.** Both packages include three meals a day starting with dinner on 11 July and the last meal is lunch on 15 July.

Team participation fee is £185.00.
