



The Paris Cup is a two-day international youth football tournament, for boys teams played in the town of La Queue En Brie. La Queue en Brie is a City of 10.000 people 20 km from Paris. The town has preserved its rural character in its natural environment, situated in the Forest of Notre-Dame where is possible to see the castle of the Marmouzetses, built in the 18th century.

Travel Arrangements - All teams require transportation during their stay at the La Queue en Brie. Most European teams use their own buses or cars to get from their accommodation to the fields or evening events. We can provide buses for you. If your team fly you need a transfer service from Airport to Hotel & Return, we will arrange this. The transport hotel-fields & return will be guaranteed by a shuttle bus. Ask more info.

Accommodation - The hotels are all in the 2-stars or 3-stars categories, situated in the towns of La Queue en Brie and Pontault Combault, one half hour from the city of Paris. Your group will be accommodated as requested in twin-bedded rooms, in 3-bedded (Pls. note 3-4bedded rooms are a big bed with extra bed/beds). All the hotels feature at least TV room, bar and cafeteria. All rooms are en suite.

Meals: based on half-board from dinner on arrival day to breakfast on departure. All meals are served in the restaurants near the hotel where you are staying (200- 800 m). Drinks are not included. During the tournament it will be possible to have lunch or sandwiches (not included) in the sport area.

Sports facilities -The tournament will be played in La queue en Brie area, in 2 Stadiums with grass pitches located in the middle of a park. The tournament is authorized by UEFA. Teams will play at least 3 matches.

Boys (11-a-side):

U17 - 2 x 25 minute halves
U16 - 2 x 25 minute halves
U15 - 2 x 20 minute halves
U14 - 2 x 20 minute halves
U13 - 2 x 20 minute halves
U12 - 2 x 20 minute halves

Boys (7-a-side):

U11 - 2 x 15 minute halves
U10 - 2 x 15 minute halves
U9 - 2 x 15 minute halves
