The Como Champions Cup

is one of Italy's biggest international Easter soccer tournaments.

Your team is invited to participate in the 9th annual edition at Easter 2010.

Between 50 and 65 teams from 10 countries are expected in 2010.

The tournament is sanctioned by the Italian Soccer Federation.

It is held each Easter and attracts teams from all parts of the world. Games are played on top quality astroturf and natural grass fields in Como, Italy and nearby Switzerland.



TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1 - Teams arrival in Como and check-in at the tournament centre. Transfer to your hotel. Accommodation, dinner and overnight.

Day 2 - After breakfast transfer to the tournament pitches in Como and surrounding area to play the qualification games. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 - After breakfast transfer to the pitches for further qualification games in the morning. First semi-final games in the afternoon. (This afternoon possibility to attend the pro match in Milan). Dinner at the hotel.

Day 4 - After breakfast transfer to the pitches for final games. In the afternoon Prize-giving ceremony at the local stadium. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 - Breakfast and teams departure.
